WHAT CHOIRS ARE AVAILABLE?

NHS offers seven choral ensembles. All students in our choral program belong to one of three primary choirs. No audition is necessary for membership in a primary chorus. Bel Canto is our primary chorus for freshman and sophomore sopranos and altos, and Select Women is our primary chorus for junior and senior sopranos and altos. Camerata is our chorus for tenors and basses in all grades.

Membership in the following ensembles is available by audition: Niceville Singers (grades 9-12, mixed), Opus One (grades 10-12 mixed), Jazz Girlz (grades 9-12), and Barbershop Boys (grades 9-12)

HOW MUCH DOES CHORUS COST?

Chorus is a bargain compared to the majority of other clubs and activities! Student pay a fair share fee of \$50 per semester, and there is a one time uniform purchase. Financial assistance is available for those in need.

WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT?

Students in a primary chorus participate in five major concerts per year. There are no regular after school rehearsals, so students can easily balance chorus and other sports or activities.

For students in auditioned groups, performance opportunities abound! Students in our top ensemble, Opus One, typically perform over twenty times during the holiday season. With multiple ensembles to choose from, any student who is interested in singing can be part of a group that has the time commitment that is right for them.

WHAT PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES ARE AVAILABLE?

The choral department has five major performances a year: The Back to School Concert in August, Holiday Concert in December, Singing Supper in February, Classical Masterworks Concert in April, and the Spring Concert in May. We participate in one adjudicated Music Performance Assessment a year, typically in March.

For students in auditioned ensembles, our chorus has a rich history of domestic and international travel. Our auditioned ensembles serve as ambassadors of Niceville High School, performing upwards of thirty times for the community throughout the school year.
